CONTINUED VALIDITY, OR RENEWAL, OF THIS PERMIT IS SUBJECT TO COMPLETE AND TIMELY COMPLIANCE WITH ALL APPLICABLE CONDITIONS, INCLUDING THE FILING OF ALL REQUIRED INFORMATION AND REPORTS.

B. THE VALIDITY OF THIS PERMIT IS ALSO CONDITIONED UPON STRICT OBSERVANCE OF ALL APPLICABLE FOREIGN, STATE, LOCAL, TRIBAL, OR OTHER FEDERAL LAW.

C. VALID FOR USE BY PERMITTEE NAMED ABOVE.

D. Acceptance of this permit serves as evidence that the permittee understands and agrees to abide by the "General Permit Conditions" and the "Special Conditions for U.S. Endangered Species Act Museum Permits" (copies attached).

E. Authorized to export and re-import shipments of non-living museum specimens of endangered and threatened species (excluding live plants, golden eagles, and bald eagles) previously legally accessioned into the permittee's collection, for the purpose of scientific research.

F. Permit may be copied for multiple shipments; permittee to retain original.

G. This permit is not valid until the information required on the attached Export/Re-import form is completed by the permittee and the permit has been validated by U.S. Fish and Wildlife personnel.

H. Permittee must submit an annual report of activities (export and re-import) conducted under this permit to the Division of Management Authority by March 31 each year this permit is valid.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR U.S. ENDANGERED SPECIES ACT MUSEUM WILDLIFE PERMITS

1. Permittee must comply with the attached "General Permit Conditions" specified by the Division of Management Authority (DMA).
2. All applicable foreign, State, local or other Federal laws, including those requiring permits under the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora, the Marine Mammal Protection Act, Migratory Bird Treaty Act, and/or Bald and Golden Eagle Protection Act, must be observed.
3. Each shipment of wildlife specimens for export/re-import must contain the following and be presented to a USFWS officer at a designated port (list attached) for validation:
 - a. The specimens being exported/re-imported;
 - b. Complete document packages (3 for export, 2 for re-import) each containing a copy of the permit, the completed Export/Re-import Report (form on the bottom of the page), and completed Wildlife Declaration (form 3-177). One package to remain with the shipment (export only), one to be retained by the USFWS officer, and one retained by the permittee for their records. A copy of the validated Export/Re-import Report must be sent to the Division of Management Authority by the permittee as part of the annual reporting requirements.
