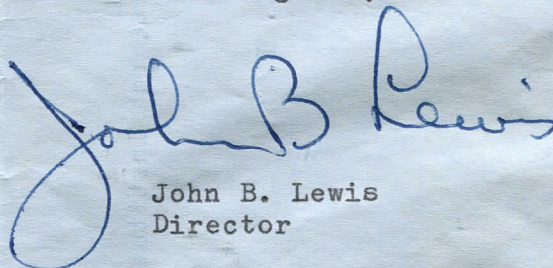

Thank you very much indeed for your letter of January 27th. It was most kind of you to undertake the identifications of the collection of gorgonians which I sent to you.

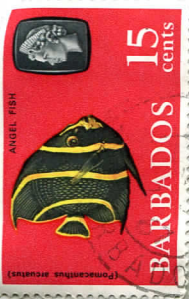
These were all obtained from the Grenadines, a small group of islands between St. Vincent and Grenada, West Indies.
