

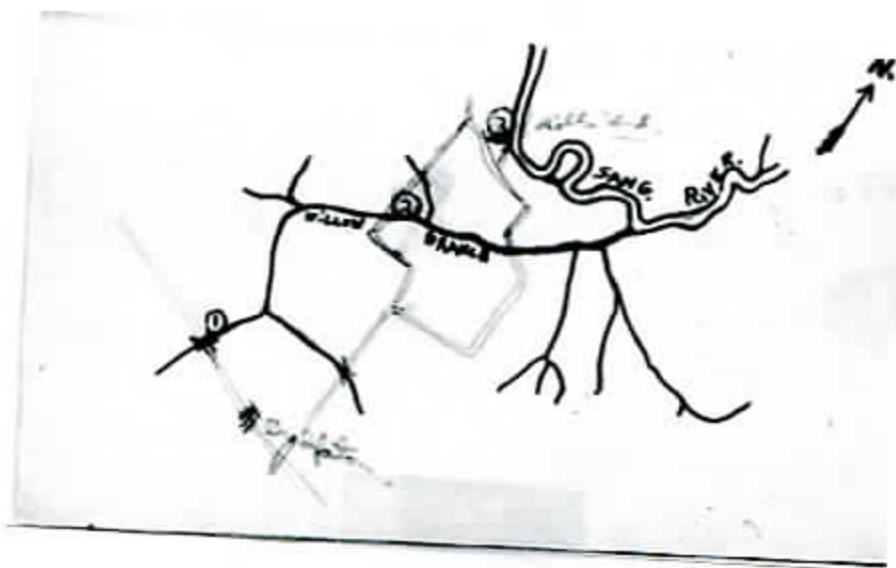

7-1/2 mi. N.W. to Bradford on Red Rock.
 1st small stream across road beyond (west of)
 Bradford.

1st fork into rough (yellowish)
 red yellow.
 margin black of stone
 under channel.

Stream 6" deep - strong flow.

7-1/2 mi. N.W. to Bradford on Red Rock.

Top most of Tens rocks to Kill'ed
 in drainage. Middle & largest
 stream of these smaller, flowing
 fastest towards drainage line.

7 more miles. 23-1926.

Beetles - slugs - snails, etc -

from Oak Forest area - on talus
 and floodplain of Long River - at
 Kill'ed fork - Long Co.

[*Calla drusea*, say.
 and *Pontederia ligularis*, say. (for fish
 & other shells and) from cutoff flood
 of floodplain - (amphib. (Zell's)).

STA 3 CONT JPEM 1713-1717

~~Some~~ most of the beetles and
 snails, etc. Come from
 a stump of talus slope -
 under logs & in rotten
 wood: the same for
 talus deposited. ground
 species:

The greatest # of beetles
 from oak tree standing.
 logs loose - under logs &
 in rotten wood -
 this last station was
 on the floodplain.
